1) The Trust shall be called "DINDIGOL ON SHARRED COCKS-EDUCATIONAL TRUST, DISDICEL."

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
- 2) The Registered Hood Office of the Trust chall be for the present in the presides in Survey No.13 B, Palent Road, Dindigul.
- The Trust has been created generally for educational, charitabel and noAreligious purposes. The objects of the Trust inter-alia are;
 - A) to spread knowledge, worldliness and human understanding.
- B) promotion of education both academic and non-academic and vocational, amongst children, shults and elders.
- C) sward of scholershipsto deserving students at all levels and continue their higher studies in and outside India.
 - D) to stard, conduct or take over educational institutions.
 - E) to extend relief to the poor amineely in cash or in hind.
 - F) to provide free medical relief and aid
- 0) to stard, or take over andorum hospitaks and dispensaries for the above purpose.
- H) to educate the people to become self-relient and be able to start some small scale cottage industry to help the economy of the

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



4) The Trustees shall stand possessed of the said assumt of th.707/-(Rupees seven hundred and seven only) referred to supra and such



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
other properties (both movable and immovable) as may be acquired from time to time by the Trust by purchase, eachange, grant, subscription, endowment denation, contribution, in any manner whatsover.

- 5) The Trustees shall have power to accept donation from any individual, instutitions, charitable organisations, associations, (etc) either in cash or movable or immovable properties either with or without any special conditions attached to it unless such conditions are repugnant to the objects of this Trust.
- 6) The Objects of the Trust shall be in general to promote activities of social nature and in particular to form, establish and run an English Medium School of the C B S E pattern from L K G to Senior Secondary Level and make the same in the long run an ideal residential school.

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- 7) To achieve the abovesaid object of establishing an English Medium School in any one of the villages adjoining the town of Dintigul. The Board of Trustees shall nominate a committee from amongst themselves and vest this committee of FIVE Trustees with full powers subject to the guidance and Policy decessions of the Board of Trustees.
- 8) The Charter Trustees shall be lifetime Trustees of the Trust. Each one will have the provilege of nominating any senter of his family to succeed his as life Trustee. This can be done by a document of instiffmentation to be sent to the Board of Trustees. Charter Trustees may co-opt one or more persons from various walks of life as Trustees of the Trust who also hold powers and privileges similar to charter Trustees, for their life time. The total number of Trustees shall not be less than STYEN and more than FIFTEEN.



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

- d) This committee shall have power and authority to appoint or engage at this discretion, remove, dismiss or suspend one or more employees on the clerical, supervisory, teaching on other menial cadres engaged on temperary, permanent or special service in connection with the work of the Trust, determine their powers and duties, and fix the salaries or empluments, and to require security in such instances and such ascents as the Committee may think fit,
- e) This committeeshall have pover in general to acquire all things and do all acts necessary to carry out this specific coject of the Trust.
- 11) The Trustees shall be entitled to reimpursement by the Trust for all expenses incurred by them with the approval of the Trust Board . The Board of Trustmes is also empowered to tatify and reishurse expenses incurred by the Trustees provided they are of thing the purview of the objects of the Trust. The Trustees shall be entitled to be idenified by the Trust equinet any consequences of all buful acts done by the Trustees in the course and discharge of their duties as the Trustoes.
- 12) Trustees other than the one sho octs as Secretary, Treasurer and Co-ordinator shall not be entitled to any remineration and shill work in an honorary capacity. However, it shall be compotent for the Trustees to incur expenditure out of Trust finds for travel and stay in and out of India for promotion of the mubjects of the Trust.

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


- 13) The Trustees may at any time invite and receive or without such invitation, receive any voluntary contribution either from the Trustees or from any other person or persons, bedies corporate, Associations, Institutions etc., by way of donations. All such contributions shall be treated as forming part of the Trust fund being the subject atter of these presents provided it shall always be for the Trustees in their absolute discretation to decide whether they should into the and/or accept any contributions and they shall at all times be at liberty to reject any contributions without giving any reasons.
- 14) The Charter Trustees may advance such sums of scney for the activities of the Trust, and such sums of scney advanced by the Trustees, shall not beer any interest and shall be repaid to them after a fixed period of 5 years and above. (FIVE YEARS)
- 15) Subject to the provisions supra, the Trustees shall not keep with them at any time more than N.5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) in cash of the Trust funds.
- 16) The Trustees shall have power to deposit the Trust moneys or any porition thereof in any Nationalised Bank or Co-operative Banking Institutions either by way of Fixed Deposit or in current account or saving Bank account to be operated upon the Secretary our Trusturer.
- 17) The Trustees shall also be we power to invest the Trust soney in any Government or any Other approved Securities and in any other manner decided by the Board of Trustees and from time to time varify the mode of investment.
- 18) The Trust moneys shall not be invested with any private individuals of firm or association or persons or body of individuals or private financiers.
- 19) For the purposes of carrying out the objects of the Trust, the Trustees shall have power to sequire by purchase or on lease or

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otherwise any immovable properties of any tenure and in case of vacant lend the Trustees shall be at inchesty liberty to errect buildings theren and to do all acts mecessary and iscidential thereto.

- 20) It shall be lawful to pull down, renovate, rebuild, alter, adopt, improve and to develop or repair any improve able property comprised in the Trust properties and to expend thereon such acceys out of the Trust fund or the income thereof as they may think fit.
- 21) The Board of Trustees may enter into any agreements or convenants with the owners of or persons entitled to or interested in any other properties and to raise funds by way of loans.
- 22) It shall be lawful for the Trustees at such time or times as they may in their absolute discretion as may be resolved at their meeting to sell by public auction or private contract or exchange or transfer or assigns or grant leases or sub-lesses for any term however long or otherwise dispose of all or any part of the Trust properties including immovable properties. In such mostings where such decisions are taken, the unanimous resolutions of the Board in this respect shall be recorded and signed by all the Trustees.
- 23) The Trustees may depose t for safe custody any documents held by them relating to any property belonging to the Trust under these presents with any bank and may pay any sum payable in respect of the same.
- 24) The entire control, regulation, management, application, and administration of the Trust properties whether capital or income, rent, interest or profit of any kind & all be in the discretion of all the trustees.

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- 25) Every power, authority or discretion conferred upon the Trustees xxx is shall be exercised or signified either by some instrument in writing to be signed by all trustees during the Board of Trustees Beeting.
- 26) The quorum for purposes of meeting will be the presence of three persons. No business except for adjourning the secting to a particular date shall be transacted at any meeting of the Trustees unless there shall be quorum.
- 27) In case of difference of opinion arising among the Trustees and in all manners wherein the Trustees shall have a discretionary power, the opinion of themajority of the Trustees present and we ting shall prevail and be binding on the majority as well as on those Trustees who may not have voted, and if the Trustees shill be equality divided in Opinion the matter shall be decided according to the casting vote of the Chairman.
- 28) The meeting of the Board of Trustees thall be held at least twice in a year but more number of the meetings may be called if considered necessary. The quorum for the meeting shall be three trustees. The meeting shall be held at any place in India at the desire of the Board of Trustees.
- 29) A minutes book thall be kept by the Trustees, Minutes of the entry into office of every new Trustees and of all proceedings of the Board of Trustees shall be signed by the Chairman of the meeting either at the conclusion thereof or at the next weting.
- 30) True and regular books of accounts of all receipts and expenditures of the Trust deall be maintained by the Trustees in English.

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
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NOW THIS DEED OF AMENDMENT OF DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

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(5) The remaining two trustees shall have the power of nominating any member of his family to succeed him in his life time or after death. This can be done a by a document in writing to be sent to the Board of Trustees.

- (7) The other clauses of the original Deed of Declaration of Trust dated 25th August 1986 shall hold good and be in force and this Deed of Amendment to the Deed of Trust shall be kept as part and parcel of the original Deed of Decisration of Trust and shall be read together.

- 07. The managing Trustee has power to appoint Trustees and has power to remove the Trustee if he is satisfied that the trustees are absent for more than three consecutive general body meetings or the Trustees act against the trust rules.
- 08. The Managing Trustee is entitled to borrow money for the purpose of the trust with or without security from bankers, financial institutions and to purchase any movable and immovable properties for the Trust.
- 09. The Managing Trustee is entitled to approach any organisation whether Government or non-Government for recognition in connection with funds, permission, registration etc., on behalf of the Trust.
- 10. The Managing Trustee is the Correspondent of the School being run in his life time, until and unless he nominates any one of the board of trustees or his legal heirs as Managing
 Trustee.







- The Managing Trustee is entitled to open bank account in any Nationalised/Scheduled Banks in the name of the Trust and he is empowered to operate the same.
- 12. The Managing Trustee is entitled to appoint representatives in the matter of dealing on Income - Tax and other matters on his behalf.
- 13. The Managing Trustee is entitled to hold the property of the trust for the objects.
- 14. The Managing Trustee is entitled to appoint personnel for the purpose of the Trust, Chartered Accountant, Legal Advisor and such other professionals on such terms as deems fit from time to time.
- 15. The Managing Trustee is entitled to file suit on behalf of the Trust and likewise defend any action taken against the trust and also to compromise and compound such cases.
- 16. The Managing Trustee is authorised to sell, lease, mortagage or otherwise deal with any of the property of the Trust both movable and immovable as may be found convenient for from time to time.
- 17. The Managing Trustee is authorised to invest the funds of the trust in accordance with the provisions of the section 13(1)(d) read with section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act 1961 and Rules made thereunder from time to time.
- 18. The Managing Trastee shall not carry on any business for the trust with the funds of the trust other than a business which is permitted under the provision of the Income-Tax Act 1961, nor would any of the Income of the trust inconsistant with Section 13(2) of the Income Tax Act 1961 so as to directly or indirectly benefit such persons referred to in section 13 of the Income Tax 1961
- 19. The Managing Trustee shall have the power to receive donations or gifts for the trust.
- 20. The Managing Trustee has the power to select, appoint or co-opt by unanimous resolutions, additional trustees to the Board of Trustees from time to time.
- 21. The Managing Trustee is authorised to frame rules for the proper conduct of the trust and administration of the trust.
- 22. The Managing Trustee is authorised to collect any fees for carrying out the object of tise trust by only to meet the actual expenses without any elements of profit.
- 23. The trust is irrevocable and no part of the funds of the trust or income of the trust shall be taken directly or indirectly for the benefit of the trustees.
- 24. The trustees shall maintain proper accounts of the Trust on an annual basis and the same shall be audised by a Chartered Accountant.

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It is hereby declared that any amendment to this trust concerning direct tax laws shall be carried out only with the prior approval of the Commissioner of the Income Tax having jurisdiction of the Commissioner of Income - tax.

26. It is declared for the removal of doubts that the objects of the Trust are not for the benefits of any particular religion community, Caste or croed.

27. If for any reasons the objects of the Trust could not be achieved or for any other reason thought fit by the Trustees, the assets and liabilities of the Trust may be amalgamated with any other Trust, charitable society or institution having similar objects who are enjoying permission under section 80G of the Income - Tax Act, 1961

28. It is hereby declared that for the removal of doubts that no activities of the trust shall be carried out outside India.

The value of the trust on that date Rs. 3,00,000,00.
